Heard Mr. I.S. Mazarbhuiyan, learned counsel for the petitioner; Ms. N. Bordoloi, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department for the respondent no. 1; and Mr. H. Sarma, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam for the respondent nos. 2 & 3.

Seeking a direction to the respondent authorities to issue regular patta to the petitioner in respect of a plot of land, covered by Dag no. 128 [Old] / 145 [New] situate at Village – Baniapara, Bilasipara Revenue Circle, District – Dhubri in terms of the provisions of the Assam Land Holding [Adoption of Relationship under the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886 in the Acquired Permanently Settled Estates] Act, 1974 on the strength of a Sale Deed and by virtue of long possession, the petitioner has preferred the present writ petition.

Issue notice, returnable on 10.06.2026.

As Ms. Bordoloi, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue Department has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent the respondent no. 1; and Mr. Sarma, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam has appeared and accepted notices on behalf of the respondent nos. 2 & 3, issuance of formal notice to the respondents is dispensed with. Mr. Mazarbhuiyan, learned counsel for the petitioner shall furnish requisite nos. of extra copies of the writ petition along with the annexures to Ms. Bordoloi and Mr. Sarma within 2 [two] working days from today.

Having regard to the projections made as regards the petitioner's long possession, it is provided that till the returnable date, the parties shall maintain status quo as existing today in respect of the plot of land referred hereinabove.
