Heard Shri R. Phukan, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Shri M. Sarma,
learned counsel for the Central Bank of India/respondent.

At the outset, Shri Phukan, the learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted

that though the initial order dated 15.05.2017 passed by the DRT was interfered with by the DRAT, Kolkata vide order dated 21.03.2018 and the matter has been remanded back, the same order of the DRAT, Kolkata is the subject matter of challenge in a writ petition filed by the respondent Bank before this Court which is registered as WP(C) No. 5395/2018 which is slated to be listed tomorrow.
