ORDER

Mr. S. Dutta, learned Standing Counsel, Revenue submits that hearing before the Revenue Authority is under way. He therefore submits that further time be granted to conclude the hearing.

Mr. A. R. Tahbildar, learned counsel for the petitioner, on the other hand, has referred to directions of this Court in the order dated 28.11.2025 passed in WP(C) No. 6756/2025. He submits that there was a direction that the review be filed within the prescribed time and that a speaking order be passed as expeditiously as possible within the outer limit of 06.03.2026.

The Revenue Department has not furnished any explanation as to why the time limit specified by the Court have not been adhered to by the Authority undertaking hearing of the Review Petition.

Be that as it may, this Court permits the Review Authorities to complete the hearing as expeditiously as possible within further period of 2 (two) weeks from today.

It is made clear that the Review Authorities must complete the hearing and pass necessary orders by 15.06.2026 and the copies thereof shall be served upon the writ petitioner.

Accordingly, re-list this matter again on 08.06.2026.
