1. We have heard Mr. D. Ullah, learned Advocate for the applicant. We have also heard Mr. T. J. Mahanta, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. P. Sarma, learned Advocate for the respondent Nos. 3, 4 and 5.

2. This Interlocutory Application has been filed for condonation of the delay of 43 days in filing the connected Review Petition against the Judgment & Order dated 19.02.2026 passed by this Court in WA No. 27/2026.

3. The learned counsel for the respondents submits that they have no instruction to object the present application.

4. Having gone through the averments made in the application, we are satisfied that good grounds have been assigned by the applicant/review petitioner for condoning the delay.
