Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Learned counsel Mr. S.P. Sharma appears on behalf of the appellant. Heard.

Perused the records.

A careful perusal of the instant case record reveals that the matter was last listed before the Lawazima Court on 11.12.2025 and on that day, the learned counsel for the appellant, Mr. S.P. Sharma had appeared before the Lawazima Court and prayed for service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5 & 6 by usual Court process. The same was allowed by the said

Lawazima Court.

But so far, no such steps have been received from the appellant.

However, the learned counsel for the appellant, Mr. S.P. Sharma has appeared before the Lawazima Court today and prayed for some more time to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondents mentioned above.

In view of the above, the appellant is afforded one week time as a final opportunity to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5 & 6 by usual process mode, failing which, the A.O.(J) of the concerned section is directed to place the matter before the Hon'ble Court.
