Heard Mr. S. K. Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. A. Chakrabarty, learned Government Advocate appearing for respondent nos. 1 and 2; Ms. T. Jain, learned standing counsel for respondent no. 3; Mr. I. Das,

learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. D. Upamanyu, learned standing counsel, Health Department for respondent no. 4, 7 and 8; Mr. V.Choudhury, learned standing counsel for respondent no. 5 and Mr. A. Chaliha, learned standing counsel appearing for respondent no. 6.

2. Although the names of the petitioner was recommended vide provisional result published on 03.05.2023 by the State Level Recruitment Commission for appointment to Class–III post as a PWD (visual impairment in both eyes with 40% disability), appointment letters have not been issued and apprehension is expressed that one year validity of the select list would expire on 08.05.2024. Hence, this writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

3. Issue notice returnable on 14.06.2024.

4. The requisite extra copy of the petition be served on the learned State and departmental counsel in course of the day.

5. Without expressing any opinion on the claim of the petitioner, in so far as the petitioner is concerned, the provisional result declared by the State Level Recruitment Commission for appointment to Class–III post purportedly declared on 03.05.2023 shall stands extended till the next date of listing.

6. Pendency of this writ petition shall not be a bar for the respondent authorities to examine the claim of the petitioner to issue appointment letter, if not already issued and if the petitioner is found entitled to appointment.
