Heard Mr. R. Karim, learned counsel for appellant.

None appeared for the respondent, though names of two counsel have been reflected in the cause list and from the submission of the learned counsel for

the appellant, it is seen that the respondent has already appeared at the time of disposal of the interlocutory application for condonation of delay.

This is appeal filed under Section 47 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1980 against the impugned order dated 27.09.2024, passed in F.C. Misc.(G) Case No. 03/2024, by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Dhubri rejecting the petition of the appellant seeking custody of the child.
