Heard Mr. A.M. Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. G. Sharma, learned Standing Counsel, NRC, Home and Political Department for the respondent nos. 2, 4 & 6; Mr. P. Sharma, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam for the respondent no. 3; and Ms. S. Katakey, learned Standing Counsel, ECI for the respondent no. 5.

2. In this writ petition, assail is made to an Order/Opinion dated 17.12.2025 passed by the learned Member, Foreigners' Tribunal No. 4, Goalpara, Assam in F.T. Case no. [G-4]M/533/18. By the Order/Opinion, the Tribunal has held that the petitioner-proceedee had failed to discharge his mandatory burden of proving himself to be not a foreigner, as required under Section 9 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 and as a result, the petitioner-proceedee has been declared to be a foreign national, who had entered India [Assam] illegally on or after 25.03.1971.

3. During the proceedings before the Tribunal, the petitioner-proceedee exhibited ten nos. of documents as Exhibit-A to Exhibit-J. Exhibit-A and Exhibit-B were Voters' List of 1966 and 1970 where the name of the petitioner-proceedee's projected father Kaser Uddin appeared. The petitioner-proceedee's name appeared in the Voter List for the first time in 1989 wherein his father's name was recorded as Baser Ali. It is the case of the petitioner-proceedee that Kaser Uddin and Baser Ali were one and the same person. For further

consideration, this Court is not deemed it proper examine the records of F.T. Case no. [G-4]M/533/18.

4. Let the case records of F.T. Case no. [G-4]M/533/18 be requisitioned.
