Heard Mr. L.M. Rahman, learned counsel for the petitioner.

This contempt petition is preferred alleging non-compliance of the direction made in an Order dated 26.08.2025 passed in a writ petition, W.P.[C] no. 2370/2025. By the said Order, the Designated Public Servant has been directed to pass a speaking and reasoned order within a period of 45 [forty five] days from the date of submission of a copy of the Order by the petitioners before him. It is averred that the Order dated 26.08.2025 was duly brought to the notice of the respondents by a Letter dated 26.09.2025, the receipt of which was acknowledged on 03.10.2025. However, despite elapse of a period of 45 days, no speaking and reasoned order has been passed.

Issue notice, returnable on 22.06.2026.

The petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon the respondents by speed post within 2 [two] working days from today.
