1. Heard Mr. K.M. Hassan, the learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. R.J. Baruah, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State of Assam.

2. This application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik

Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Rume Sultan Basha @Sultan Ali, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bhuragaon P.S. Case No. 13/2025, under Section 111/140(3)/(3)(5) of the BNS, 2023.

3. The gist of accusation in this case is that on 01.03.2025, the mother of the victim girl had lodged an FIR before the Officer-In-Charge of Bhuragaon Police Station, *inter alia*, alleging that the accused persons named in the FIR, including the present petitioner had kidnapped the daughter of the first informant.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the perusal of the FIR would show that the victim girl is 18 years of age and he submits that the victim is in a romantic relationship with the present petitioner.

5. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the victim has already been recovered and considering the fact, his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

6. On the other hand, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that considering the nature of offence involved in this case, the perusal of the Case Diary may be necessary.

7. Considering the nature of accusation and the facts and the facts and circumstances of this case, the perusal of the Case Diary would be necessary for consideration of the instant bail application.

8. Hence, call for the same.
