Heard Ms. K. Devi, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents, while regularizing his service vide order dated 04.06.2008, failed to extend the benefit of his past service for purpose of pension as was earlier represented before this Court and, instead, compelled him to furnish an undertaking excluding him from the coverage of the Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969, thereby adversely affecting his pensionary rights.

Issue notice, returnable by 4 (four) weeks.

As Ms. S. Chutia, learned Standing Counsel, Elementary Education Department and Ms. R.M. Baruah, learned Standing Counsel, Finance have appeared and accepted notice on behalf of all the respondents, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents.
