Heard Mr. S. Khound, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D. Upamanyu, learned Standing Counsel for the Higher Education Department and Mr. A. Chaliha, learned Standing Counsel, Finance Department.

The grievance of the petitioner in this case is the attempted recovery of alleged excess pay on a wrong appreciation of the benefits of the Assam Revision of Pay Rules, 2017.

The learned counsel for the petitioner draws the attention of this Court to the order dated 27.02.2026 passed in WP(C) No. 1157/2026 to submit that the petitioner is similarly situated and this matter can be tagged along with the other matters for a proper adjudication.

The learned counsels for the respondents have not objected to the aforesaid proposition.

Accordingly, list this matter along with W.P(C) No. 1157/2026 on 03.06.2026. The interim order governing the aforesaid writ petition shall

also govern the present writ petition.

Since the matter is to be listed on 03.06.2026, notices are not issued at the moment. However, petitioner shall serve extra copies of the writ petition upon the learned counsels appearing for the respondents to enable them to have their instructions in this matter also.
