Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the case record reveals that the instant matter was earlier listed before the Lawazima Court on 17.10.2025 and vide the order passed on the said date, the Lawazima Court was pleased to direct the petitioner to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 6 by way of speed post mode.

Vide the said order, the petitioner was also directed to file necessary affidavit reflecting the service status of *dasti notice* dated 23.05.2023 issued to the respondent No. 6

Thereafter, the instant matter was listed before the Lawazima Court again on 10.12.2025 and on that day, the Lawazima Court was pleased to afford further one week time to the petitioner to comply with the earlier Lawazima Court's order dated 17.10.2025.

But so far, the petitioner has neither taken fresh steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 6 nor has furnished requisite affidavit regarding service of *dasti notice* upon the same respondent.

Taking into consideration of the petitioner's failure to comply with the Lawazima Court's orders and the non-appearance from the petitioner's side before the Lawazima Court, this court is of the view that the petitioner may not be interested to further pursue the instant case. Hence, the matter is laid before the Hon'ble Court for necessary orders.
