Heard Mr. Zakir Hussain, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. R. M. Baruah, learned standing counsel, Finance Department, appearing on behalf

of respondent No. 1; and Mr. S. M. T. Chistie, learned standing counsel, Secondary Education Department, appearing on behalf of respondents No. 2, 3 & 4.

2. The petitioner is a retired Assistant Teacher. It is contended that he is entitled to an arrear salary of Rs. 66,100/- w.e.f. 01.04.2016 to 28.02.2020. However, the same has not been released to him although non-drawal certificate was issued by the Headmaster-cum-DDO, Idgah High School, District Sribhumi, Assam, way back on 29.11.2024.

3. By filing this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India; the petitioner prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to release and pay his arrear salary amounting to Rs. 66,100/-.

4. Issue notice.

5. As Ms. Baruah, learned standing counsel, Finance Department, and Mr. Chistie, learned standing counsel, Secondary Education Department, have appeared and accepted notice on behalf of their respective respondents, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, they shall be furnished with the requisite extra copies of the petition during the course of the day.
