Heard Mr. C Chakravarty, learned counsel for the applicant, who submits that by filing this application, the applicant seeks condonation of

delay of 82 (eighty two) days in filing the connected appeal under Section 415(2) of the BNSS, 2023 against the judgment and order dated 28.11.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Margherita in Sessions Case No.210(M)/2015 convicting the applicant under Section 302 of the IPC and sentencing him to undergo imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/- with a default clause.
