Heard Mr. K. Talukdar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. M. Sharma, learned standing counsel, IOCL appearing for the respondent.

The petitioner in the above noted writ petition has assailed the order dated 11-05-2026 issued by the respondent No. 1/ Corporation rejecting the prayer of the petitioner to accept the tanker truck(s) offered by him under the Agreement to Sale (ATS) provision, incorporated in the corrigendum 04-04-2025, issued to the NIT dated 01-03-2025.

The contentions of the rival parties made in the present writ petition would require deeper consideration.

Issue notice of motion returnable in 03 weeks.

Since Mr. S.S. Roy, learned CGC has accepted notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and Mr. M. Sarma has accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 to 7, service of notice is complete in this case.

However, extra copies of the writ petition, requisite in numbers, be furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents during the course of the day.

The cancellation of the tanker truck(s) of the petitioner, offered under the ATS scheme, shall be subject to the outcome of the present writ petition.
