Heard Mr. H. Buragohain, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P.

Sharmah, learned standing counsel, AFDC.

The petitioner in the present writ petition has assailed the procedure adopted by the respondent authorities towards settlement of the Dighali Bhangamur Fishery, Sivasagar.

From the materials brought on record it is evident that the financial bids of the bidders have already been opened and the petitioner is found to have been placed at Sl. No. 7, out of the 08 (eight) bidders. Insofar as, the contention made in the present writ petition is concerned, there is no allegation against the bidder whose bid value is found to be the highest.

Issue notice returnable in 04 weeks.

Since Mr. P. Sharma has accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4, no formal notice is required to be sent to the said respondents.

However, extra copies of the writ petition, requisite in numbers, be furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents during the course of the day.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon respondent Nos. 5 to 7 by speed post.

Steps within 02 working days.

The settlement of the Dighali Bhangamur Fishery shall be subject to the outcome of the present writ petition.
