[1] Heard Mr. S.K. Goswami, the learned counsel appearing for the appellant.

[2] This appeal under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 has been preferred by the Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd., impugning the judgment and award dated 20.12.2021, passed by the learned Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Goalpara in MAC Case No. 321/2017.

[3] The appellant is basically aggrieved with the quantum of compensation awarded to the claimants/respondents.

[4] This appeal is admitted.

[5] Let the records of MAC Case No. 321/2017 be called for from the concerned Tribunal.

[6] The learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits that in the connected interlocutory application, which has already been disposed of, the respondent Nos. 3 and 4 have been represented by their engaged counsel and their names are also reflected in

the cause-list.

[7] The learned counsel appearing for the appellant further submits that he will serve the notice personally to the learned counsel for the engaged counsel for the respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

[8] Prayer is allowed.

[9] As regards other respondents, namely, respondent Nos. 1 and 2, let the notice be issued.

[10] The appellant shall take steps for issuance of notice on the said respondents by speed post as well as by usual mode within 7(seven) days from the date of this order, returnable on 8th June, 2026.
