**ORDER**

Heard Mr. A.K. Sarma, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Ms. P. Rava, learned standing counsel appearing on behalf of Ms. A. Gayan, learned CGC appearing for the respondents.

The petitioner in the present writ petition has presented a challenge to an order dated 13-04-2026 by which the petitioner firm has been debarred from participating in procurement process of the department for a period of 02 (two) years from the date of issuance of the said communication.

Mr. Sarma has contended that said debarment order dated 13-04-2026 was not preceded by any show-cause notice informing the petitioner about the decision arrived at by the respondent authority to debar the petitioner from participating in the tender process along with the reasons for the same.

Issue notice returnable in 04 weeks.

Since Ms. P. Rava has accepted notice on behalf of all the respondents, service of notice is complete in this case.

However, extra copies of the writ petition, requisite in numbers, be furnished to the

learned CGC during the course of the day.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, that the petitioner firm came to be debarred from participating in any procurement process, for a period of 02 (two) years, without affording an opportunity to it in this connection, the impugned order dated 13-04-2026, to the extent it debar the petitioner firm from participating in any procurement process of the department, shall remain stayed. It is clarified that the further direction contained in the order dated 13-04-2026 for forfeiture of Performance Security as per GeM GTC and GFR is not interfered with.

Registry to list this matter again after 04 weeks on a date to be fixed by it.
