Heard Mr. M. Shah, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Aggrieved by the freezing of his saving bank account, being account No.

20196119671 in the respondent State Bank of India, Beltola Branch, on the basis of the report of cybercrime authorities at Panbazar, Guwahati as regards disputed transaction of Rs.7,913.62/- and Rs.8,063/-, this writ petition is instituted by the petitioner, seeking a direction to allow the petitioner to operate his saving bank account.

It is the contention of the petitioner that the petitioner has no idea and knowledge with regard to the disputed transactions. The petitioner maintained balance amount of Rs.2,10,661.58/-. However, the alleged disputed transaction is only amounting to Rs.15,976.62/-.

Issue notice, returnable by three weeks.

The petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon the respondents by registered post as well as by usual process within two working days.

List this matter after **3(three) weeks**.
