Heard Mr. S. Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner.

By filing this writ petition, the petitioner is seeking transfer of DDR PS UD Case No. 12/2022 dated 23.11.2022 (GDE No. 12 of 2022) to the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) or any other investigating agency for ensuring a free, fair and impartial investigation into the alleged murder of his brother, namely, *Late Shuchandra Das*.
