Heard Mr. S. Khound, learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. This is an application under Section 24 of the CPC by the petitioner, who is the estranged wife of the respondent, and she is seeking transfer of matrimonial proceedings, being Matrimonial Suit Case No.96/2026 from the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court at Nalbari to the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court at Kmarup (M), Guwahati.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner is taking care of 2 (two) minor children of the parties. Moreover, the respondent is also participating in domestic violence case filed by the petitioner against the respondent which is presently pending before the Court of JMFC No.3, Kamrup (M), Guwahati.

4. Issue notice returnable on 19.06.2026.

5. The petitioner shall take steps within 2 (two) days for service of notice on the respondents by speed post with A/D.

6. The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to collect the postal track number and to submit the postal track report prior to the next date of listing.

7. As an interim measure till the next returnable date further proceedings of Matrimonial Suit Case No.96/2026, pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Nalbari shall remain stayed.

8. The petitioner shall cause production of a certified copy of the order

before the said learned Court to make the order effective.
