Heard Mr. Tapobrat Chhetri, learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioners. Also heard Mr. S. Das, learned standing counsel, Higher Education Department, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 4, and Ms. R. M. Baruah, learned standing counsel, Finance Department, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 & 5.

2. By filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India; the petitioners prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to release their arrear monthly salary/remuneration amounting to Rs. 1,02,000/-, each, for the month of February, 2025, and for 11(eleven) days for the month of March, 2025, till their release from service on 11.03.2025.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within 4(four) weeks.

As Mr. Das, learned standing counsel, Higher Education Department, and Ms. Baruah, learned standing counsel, Finance Department, have appeared and accepted notice on behalf of their respective respondents, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, they shall be furnished with the requisite extra copies of the petition during the course of the day.
