Heard Mrs. A. Gayan learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. K. P. Pathak, learned Standing Counsel for the APDCL.

**2.** The grievance of the petitioner is that being the first wife of late Rama Kanta Rabha, she is entitled to atleast 50% of the pension and the same has not been released by the APDCL authority. On the other hand, they had released 50% of the pension to the daughter of the second wife. Being aggrieved, the petitioner is before this Court.
