Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

Perusal of the instant case record reveals that the previous Lawazima Court vide its order dated 13.06.2025 had directed the petitioner to take fresh steps for issuance of notice to the respondent No. 5 by registered post with A/D, within 7 (seven) days from the date of this order.

However, perusal of the recent office note dated 23.06.2025, it has been observed that the petitioner has not yet taken any steps for service of notice upon the aforesaid respondent, despite being directed to that effect.

In view of the above, the petitioner is further granted 7(seven) days time to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 5 by way of registered post with A/D mode.
