Heard Ms. T. Wapangla, learned counsel for the petitioner.

2] The petitioner before this Court is presently serving under the CRPF posted at 10 BN, CRPF, Howly. The petitioner's grievance is that his former wife who was the nominee in his service book is the accused of heinous crime of killing the mother of the petitioner for that criminal proceeding is undergoing. Therefore, he has filed an application before the authorities praying for deletion of her name by putting the name of his father namely Sobur Ali as nominee. The said representation filed before the authorities has not been disposed of therefore, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3] It appears to the Court that the only prayer of the petitioner is seeking deletion of the name of nominee reflected in the service book of the writ petition who happens to be the former wife of the petitioner as it stated that the petitioner has already obtained divorce by the Muslim Marriage & Divorce Registrar and Kazi, Bahari Bazar, Tarabari, Barpeta by certificate dated 11.02.2024. Under such circumstances the Court is of the view that the former wife should have been arrayed as a party respondent as her name sought to be deleted as a nominee in the service book of the

petitioner. The petitioner will take steps to implead the former wife of the petitioner by filing appropriate application before the Court.

4] Relist this matter again on 15.06.2026.
