Heard Mr. Parthib Kumar Goswami, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. B.P. Borah, learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that the petitioner took part in the selection process for appointment to the post of Constable in the Home Guards, Assam. The petitioner's grievance is that he was not given 3 marks for his Diploma/Certificate Course from IIT Polytechnic, which he produced at the time of the Physical Efficiency Test (PET). The petitioner's total mark was 63.72, which should have been 66.72 if he had been given the additional 3 marks at the time of production of his Diploma/Certificate Course from IIT Polytechnic.

Issue Notice to respondent nos.1 to 5 only returnable in 4 (four) weeks.

Mr. S.S. Roy, learned Government Advocate accepts notice for the respondent nos.1 to 5.

Mr. S.S. Roy shall obtain instructions with regard to why the petitioner was not provided 3 marks for the Diploma Certificate produced by him at the time of PET and also obtain instructions with regard to cut off marks required for general category candidates.

List the matter after four weeks.
