Heard Mr. A. Rahman, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D.J. Das, learned CGC; Mr. J. Payeng, learned standing counsel for the FT and Border matters; Ms. M. Singha, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Ms. S. Katakey, learned standing counsel for the ECI; and Mr. P. Sarmah, learned Additional Senior Govt. Advocate for the State respondent.

2. By filing this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has assailed the impugned opinion dated 31.05.2022, passed by the learned Member, Foreigners Tribunal 1<sup>st</sup>, Silchar, in F.T. 1<sup>st</sup> (D) Case No. 0426/2011, arising out of I/Case No. 4338/1998, by which the petitioner was declared as an illegal migrant of post 25.03.1971 stream.

3. Issue notice returnable on 31.07.2026.

4. Requisite extra copies of the writ petition be furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents within 2 (two) working days.
