[1] Heard Ms. L. Sharma, the learned counsel appearing for the appellant.

[2] On perusal of the Office Note dated 30.04.2026, it appears that the postal track consignment report of the notice issued to respondent Nos. 1,2 and 4 shows that the notice were delivered to the addressees. Hence, the notice on the aforesaid respondents is held to
