Heard Mr. J.U. Ahmed, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner had earlier approached this Court by a writ petition, W.P.[C] no. 4570/2020 with a grievance that an amount of Rs. 59,22,000/- had not been disbursed to the petitioner against 2 [two] no. of contract works, the petitioner had executed the contract work for the respondent BTC authorities. The said writ petition was disposed of by an order dated

19.08.2021 with a direction to the respondent no. 2 therein to examine the claim of the petitioner within a period of 45 [forty-five] days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order and, then, if the claim admitted, the respondent authorities would process the claim in accordance with law and in the light of the direction contained in *Tamsher Ali and others vs. State of Assam and others* reported in 2008 [4] GLT 1 [FB].

Alleging non-compliance of the direction contained in the order dated 19.08.2021 passed in W.P.[C] no. 4570/2020 the petitioner has approached this Court by this application under Section 12 of the Contempt of Court Act 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India.

Issue notice of motion, returnable in 4 [four] weeks.

The petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon the sole respondent by registered post with A/D as well as by usual process within a period of 3 [three] days from today.
