2. Upon consideration of the averments as well as on perusal of the relevant documents appended to this contempt petition, let notice be issued upon the alleged contemnor to show cause as to why a proceeding, as required under sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, *read with* Article 215 of

the Constitution of India should not be initiated against her, for her willful and deliberate violation of this Court's order dated 05.06.2025 passed in WP(c)5587/2016, and/or why such further or other order(s) should not be passed as to this Court may deem fit and proper.

- 3.** The notice is made returnable within 4(four) weeks.

- 4.** Learned counsel for the petitioners shall take necessary steps for causing service of notice upon the sole respondent by Speed Post as well as by usual process within a week from today.

- 5.** List it after 4(four) weeks on a date to be fixed by the Registry.
