Heard Mr. P. Bhardwaj, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. B. Gogoi, learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8.

2. By filing this writ petition, the petitioners seek a direction to the respondents to permit them to appear in the 4th BHMS Regular Examination scheduled to be held in June, 2026, pursuant to the notification dated 15.05.2026, and further to consider and dispose of the representations dated 18.05.2026 and 22.05.2026 submitted by the petitioners, by taking into consideration the power of relaxation available under the governing Regulations.

- 3.** Issue notice to the respondents, returnable by 17.06.2026.
- 4.** Since Mr. Gogoi, learned Additional Advocate General, has entered appearance and accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8, no formal notice is required to be issued to the said respondents. However, a requisite extra copy of the petition shall be furnished to him within three days from today.
- 5.** The learned counsel for the petitioners shall take steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 3 by speed post as well as by usual process within one week from today.
- 6.** The learned Additional Advocate General is requested to obtain instructions and place the same before this Court for consideration.
- 7.** List the matter again on **17.06.2026**.
