Heard Mr. P. Khataniar, learned counsel for the petitioners.

2. Upon consideration of the averments as well as on perusal of the relevant documents appended to this contempt petition, let notice be issued upon the alleged contemnors to show cause as to why a proceeding, as required under section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, *read with* Article 215 of the Constitution of India should not be initiated against them, for their willful and deliberate violation of this Court's order dated 19.12.2025 passed in WP(c)2912/2024, and/or why such further or other order(s) should not be passed as to this Court may deem fit and proper.

3. The notice is made returnable within 4(four) weeks.
