The petitioner who had retired as Assistant Teacher of Sankardev M.E. School claims for payment of leave salary/leave encashment.

It is the contention of the petitioner that after his retirement in the year 2025, he has been paid only nominal amount of Rs.56,656/- without paying the full leave salary/leave encashment, which is the legal entitlement of the petitioner.
