Heard Mr. A.K. Baruah, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. R. Dhar, learned Addl. Senior Government Advocate for the respondents Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 5; Mr. S. K. Medhi, learned Standing Counsel, Accountant General for the respondent No.4.

2] The petitioner is aggrieved that despite the petitioner having superannuated from service on 31.01.2026, neither his regular pension nor his provisional pension has been released by the respondents. The petitioner suspects that his regular pension has not been released because of non finalization of the pension papers as the name of the petitioner's wife being the nominee has been wrongly recorded by the authorities. However, under the Rules the petitioner is entitled to be granted the provisional pension.

3] The respondents will complete their instructions and file necessary affidavits, if so advised.

4] Meanwhile the pendency of the writ petition will not be a bar to release the provisional pension of the writ petitioner.

5] Relist the matter after four weeks.
