Heard Mr. J. Laskar, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner is a final-year MBBS student pursuing his medical education at North East Medical College, Sylhet, Bangladesh. In the year 2020, the petitioner appeared in the NEET(UG) examination bearing Roll No. 1402105359.

It is the case of the petitioner that in order to appear in the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE), scheduled to be held in December, 2026, he is required to produce his NEET (UG), 2020 Score Card. Having lost the original Score Card, the petitioner approached the concerned authorities seeking issuance of a copy thereof. It is the grievance of the petitioner that despite such request, no response has been received from the respondent authorities. Therefore, prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to issue the copy of said Score Card.

Issue notice, returnable by 3 (three) weeks.

As Mr. K. Gogoi, learned Central Government Counsel, for respondent Nos. 1 & 2, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents, no formal notice need be served upon the said respondents. However, he shall be furnished with requisite extra-copy of the petition.
