Heard Mr. P.K. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel representing the
informant.

2. This is an application filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for granting pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

3. On 03/12/2025 one Musst. Nirupama Begum, W/o- Mukibuz Zaman R/O- B.G. Road, Cherekapar, village- Hatimuria, Sivasagar, Assam has lodged a Complaint Petition before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dibrugarh, Assam seeking direction for registration of F.I.R. against seven persons including the Circle Officer of Moran Revenue Circle, Lot Mandal, Gaon Pradhan, Sheristadar of the Office of Civil Judge (Jr. Div) Dibrugarh, L.R. Staff of Moran Revenue Circle and two other persons. The said Complaint Petition was registered and numbered as Misc. Case No.129/2025. The prime allegations against the accused persons named in the said Complaint is that the accused No.1 (Smti. Queen Gogoi) who is the Circle Officer of Moran Revenue Circle along with the accused No.2 (Lot Mandal) and accused No.7 (L.R. Staff) have withdrawal the Online Objection of Sale Permission lodged by the Complainant without her consent and by forging her signature and preparing a false attendance/Hajira on the date of hearing of the objection. The allegations against the Sheristadar of the Office of Civil Judge (Jr. Div) Dibrugarh is that he has issued Form-50 suppressing the case pending before the said court against the Dag and Patta land where the Complainant has made online objection. Accused No.4 and 5 with the help of accused No.3 (Gaon Pradhan) and other accused persons have

obtained land sale permission etc.

4. The Learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Dibrugarh after perusal of records and after receipt of report from concern police station vide order dated 19-05-2026 has pleased to disposed of the Misc. Case No.129/2025 with a direction to the Officer-in-Charge, Moran Police Station to immediately register an FIR under appropriate provisions of law including Section 201, 217, 318, 336, 336(3) and 61(2) of the BNS, 2023 and any other relevant provisions disclosed during investigation.

5. One Bitu Zaman, mother's name Nirupama Begum resident of- Bora Road Babupatty Ward No.04, Sivasagar, Assam-785640 has again lodged an FIR before the Officer-in-Charge of Moran Police Station against Smti. Mary V. Ralsun (present petitioner), Sri Prodip Handique, Sri Debeswar Saikia, Faijun Nisha, Mohbubul Hoque, Smti. Dimpi Senapati and others. After receipt of the aforesaid FIR, Moran Police Station has registered a case on 05-06-2026 being Moran P.S. Case No.34/2026 under Section 201 / 217 / 318 (4) / 336 (3)/ 61 (2) / 3 (5) BNS, 2023 and investigation set into motion.

6. The enquiry report submitted by the police dated 15.05.2026 before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dibrugarh has been placed before the Court by the learned counsel for the informant wherein, the statements of the petitioner as well as other witness are also present. It appears that the petitioner was

earlier also interrogated by the police in course of the said enquiry.

7. Call for the Case Dairy. Having regard to the contents of the said enquiry report, I am of the view that interim protection is called for keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a government servant.

8. Accordingly, it is provided that the petitioner in the event of arrest in connection with Moran P.S. Case No. 34/2026 shall be allowed on bail on furnishing of a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Arresting Authority. It is further provided that the petitioner shall co-operated with the investigation and appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days from today. It is further provided that the petitioner shall not try to influence the witnesses in any manner.

9. List the matter again on 18.07.2026.

10. Report of the enquiry submitted by the learned counsel for the informant be kept on record.
