1. Heard Mr. R. Goswami, learned counsel for the appellant. Also heard Mr. S. Dutta, learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.1.
2. It appears that notice to respondent No.2 has returned with an endorsement that it could not be served as no such person was found in the given address. Moreover, the local people of the area also declared that no such person is known to them.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the appellant has preferred this appeal mainly on the question of quantum of compensation awarded to the claimant and they are not dishonouring their liabilities. Hence, he submits that the name of the respondent No.2, who is the owner of the offending vehicle, may be struck off.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent No. 1 does not have any objection to the said prayer. Hence, the prayer is allowed.
5. The name of the respondent No. 2 may be struck off from the Memo of Appeal. The Registry to do the needful.
