Learned counsel Ms. F. Begum appears on behalf of Mr. S. Banik, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The office note dated 23.02.2024 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent No. 5 by way of registered post with A/D on 19.07.2023.

But till date, neither the A/D card nor the un-served notice has been received back. In addition to the aforesaid, the track consignment report is also not available in respect of the aforesaid respondent **(respondent No. 5)**.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the respondent No. 5 by registered post with A/D as well as through *dasti mode*, within 7 (seven) days.
