Heard Ms. A. Agarwal, learned counsel for the petitioner. I have also
heard Mr. D. Mazumdar, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. S. Biswas,

learned counsel, who submits that in terms of the order dated 09.05.2019 passed by this Court the necessary instructions could not be obtained by his junior since the authorized representative of the respondent company, who is well versed to the facts and circumstances of the case, has been arrested by the police on 10.05.2019. Under the circumstances, two weeks further time has been prayed for by Mr. Mazumdar so as to produce certain vital documents. The learned senior counsel could not, however, indicate as to what documents are sought to be produced by the respondent to oppose the prayer made in this petition.

Although in the order dated 09.05.2019 this court has clearly observed that no further adjournment shall be granted in this case, yet considering the intervening developments leading to the arrest of one of the directors of the respondent company, I deem it appropriate to grant time till 21.05.2019, as last chance to the respondent, to produce materials, if any, sought to be relied by it.

The matter be listed again on 21.05.2019 for further hearing and delivery of judgment.
