Heard Mr. D. Talukdar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D.P.
Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, for granting the

privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

On perusal of the FIR, it appears that the victim was in love affair with the accused/petitioner and eloped with him but, she was not accepted by the parents of the petitioner. Thereafter, the accused took her to another place where he committed forcible sexual intercourse with her.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has been lodged because the parents of the petitioner did not accept her. Moreover, the FIR has been lodged 20 days after the alleged occurrence.

Call for the Case Diary.

In the interim it is provided that petitioner in the event of his arrest in connection with Panigaon P.S. Case No. 30/2026, registered under Section 69 of BNS, shall be released on interim bail of furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Authority. It is further provided that the petitioner shall not try to influence the witnesses in any manner.

List the matter again on 22.07.2026.
