The petitioner herein, is presently working as Deputy General Manager (DGM) under the APDCL. He is aggrieved by the promotion given to the respondent no. 5 by contending that such promotion has been effected in contravention of the reservation rules applicable to ST(P) category candidate, such as the writ petitioner.
