Case taken up before the Lawazima Court.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Perused the records.

Perusal of the recent office note dated 12.11.2025 reveals that notice was issued to the respondent Nos. 5 & 6 by registered post with A/D on 20.06.2025.

But, in respect of the aforesaid notice issued to the respondent Nos. 5 & 6, it appears that neither the A/D cards nor any un-served notices have been received by the concerned section till date.

Further, it appears that the postal track consignment details regarding the aforementioned notice issued to the respondent Nos. 5 & 6 have been generated by the concerned section and tagged with the case record at **Flag-'TC'**.
