ORDER

The petitioner herein is aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the respondent authorities in finalizing the family pension and the delay caused thereof.

2. This Court finds it very pertinent to take note of the reasons which were assigned in the communication dated 20.09.2021 and further the affidavit so filed by the respondent No.6 and more particularly, at paragraph No.6.

3. From the said communication dated 20.09.2021 and paragraph 6 of the affidavit filed by the respondent No.6, it therefore appears that only on the ground that the petitioner has not been able to provide the decree of divorce

passed in F.C (Civil) No.395/2005 dated 05.06.2006, the family pension to which the petitioner along with one Ankeeta Talukdar is entitled to have been withheld.

4. This Court, accordingly, fixes this writ petition on 16.02.2026.

5. In the meantime, this Court directs the Principal Judge, Family Court, Kamrup(M) at Guwahati to provide a certified copy of the decree of Case No. F.C (Civil) No.395/2005 to the petitioner on production of a certified copy of the present order.

6. It is further observed that in the circumstance, a certified copy of the decree is not furnished to the petitioner, the reasons, thereof, be assigned by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Kamrup(M) at Guwahati before this Court through the Registrar (Judicial) of this Registry.
