Heard Mr. N. Nath, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D. Bhattacharya, learned Standing Counsel for the Accountant General and Ms. A. Talukdar, learned State for the respondent no.1.

The matter pertains to claim of pensionary benefits.

It is noticed that the petitioner had married late Ramen Talukdar after he had divorced with his first wife. Out of the wedlock of late Ramen Talukdar and Smt. Kartar Kaur, a girl child was born, namely, Miss Ankeeta Talukdar. It appears that she has also made an application claiming for pensionary benefits of her late father. Although, pensionary benefits in favour of the petitioner has not been completed, due to non-submission of certified copy of decree of divorce, considering that the daughter of late Ramen Talukdar has become

major and has not arrayed as party in this proceedings, I deem it appropriate to allow the learned counsel for the petitioner to take instructions from the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner may also file appropriate affidavit clarifying the stand of the daughter of late Ramen Taludar, namely, Miss Ankeeta Talukdar, if occasion arise.
