Heard Mr. M. Dutta, learned counsel for the appellant and Ms. N.A. Begum, learned counsel for the respondent No. 1.

2. In this appeal, under Section 173 of the M.V. Act, the appellant has put to challenge the correctness or otherwise of the Judgment and Award dated 17.02.2025, passed by the learned Member, M.A.C.T. No. 2, Kamrup (M) at Guwahati, in M.A.C. Case No. 2079/2021, registered under Section 166 of the M.V. Act.

3. It is to be noted here that vide impugned Judgment and Award dated 17.02.2025, the learned tribunal has directed the appellant insurance company to pay a sum of Rs. 17,23,360.50/- to the respondent No. 1 being the compensation.

4. Perused the memo of appeal as well as the grounds mentioned therein and also perused the Judgment and Award dated 17.02.2025, passed by the learned tribunal, in M.A.C. Case No. 2079/2021.

5. The appeal is admitted.

6. Let notice be issued to the respondents, within a week from today, by registered post with A/D as well as by usual process and returnable in 4 weeks. As Ms. Begum has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent No. 1, no formal notice is required to be issued. However, extra requisite copy of the petition be furnished to her during the course of the day.

7. The Registry shall call for the record from the learned tribunal.

8. List the matter after 4 (four) weeks.
