Heard Mr. M. Islam, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. B. Sarma, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam.

2. This is an application under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 praying for grant of pre-arrest bail to the accused/petitioner, namely, **Shri Akkas Ali Khan** who is apprehending arrest in connection with **Mankachar P.S. Case No. 74/2025** (GR No.150/2025) under Sections 420/468/465/471/34 of the IPC.

3. It is submitted by Mr. Islam, learned counsel that the present petitioner is

the owner of the vehicle which met with an accident at Tura, Meghalaya and the vehicle was duly registered at the relevant time of accident and he is ready to produce all the relevant documents including the insurance policy before the Court of MACT.

4. Further, the petitioner is not aware as to if any documents were produced by the driver of the vehicle after the accident, because he fled away from the place of accident and subsequently, it has come to the knowledge of the present petitioner that there was some confusion in regard to policy number.

5. However, the petitioner is ready to extend his cooperation in the further investigation of the case, if he is granted with some interim protection.

6. One of the co-accused, i.e., the agent of the insurance company has already been granted with the privilege of interim pre-arrest bail and the present petitioner is also ready and willing to extend his cooperation.

7. Mr. Sarma, learned APP submitted that the case diary may be called for to know the actual fact of the case. However, it is a fact that there is some confusion in regards to the insurance policy, which has been produced before the Court of MACT. But the Form 54 speaks about the original policy number which the petitioner is claiming.

8. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and also the circumstances of this case, this Court is of the opinion that some interim protection may be provided to the present petitioner, till receipt of the case diary.

9. Accordingly, it is provided that in the event of arrest of the accused/petitioner, namely, **Shri Akkas Ali Khan** in connection with **Mankachar P.S. Case No. 74/2025** (GR No.150/2025) under Sections

420/468/465/471/34 of the IPC, he shall be enlarged on interim pre-arrest bail on his executing a bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) only with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer of the case within a period of 7 (seven) days from today to enable recording of his statement;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the investigation of the case and shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required in connection with the investigation of the aforesaid P.S. Case and
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

10. List the matter, accordingly, on **23.07.2026** for production of the updated Case diary.
