Heard Ms. A. Hussain, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. N. Das, learned Junior Government Advocate, Assam for the respondent nos. 1, 3 & 4; Mr. B. Gogoi, learned Standing Counsel, Finance and Taxation Department for the respondent no. 5.

The petitioner has a grievance that the respondent no. 6 has been carrying out construction in an unauthorised manner. The petitioner has

submitted complaints before the respondent North Lakhimpur Development Authority on a number of occasions including a Representation dated 19.12.2025. Aggrieved by inaction on the part of the North Lakhimpur Development Authority [the respondent no. 2] in taking steps in respect of the unauthorised construction carried out by the respondent no. 6, the petitioner is before this Court by the instant writ petition.

Issue notice, returnable on 14.08.2026.

As Mr. Das, learned Junior Government Advocate, Assam has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1, 3 & 4 and Mr. Gogoi, learned Standing Counsel, Finance and Taxation Department has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of the respondent no. 5, issuance of formal notices to the said respondents are dispensed with. However, requisite nos. of extra copies of the writ petition along with annexures are to be furnished Mr. Das and Mr. Gogoi within 2 [two] working days from today.

The petitioner shall take steps for service of notice upon the respondent nos. 2 & 6 by speed post within 2 [two] working days from today.
