Heard Mr. B.M. Choudhury, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. D.P. Goswami, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam, for the State respondent.

2. This is an application filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik

Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, praying for granting of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner namely, **Sri Angarag Barooah @ Jaan Barooah @ Nakul Barooah @ Jyoti Barooah**, in connection with **Moranhat P.S. Case No. 25/2026** under Section 318(3)/ 319(2)/ 69/ 83/ 316(2)/ 336(3)/ 82(2)/351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The FIR in the instant case is a very lengthy one mentioning the numerous incidents which primarily revolve around obtaining of loans by the petitioner in the name of his wives and it is alleged that the petitioner is a habitual cheat.

4. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready to cooperate with the investigation and to place all necessary documents before the I.O. to the face the case.

5. Call for the case diary.

6. Having regard to the nature of allegation, it is provided that in the event the petitioner appears before the investigating authority within ten days from today to cooperate with the investigation, then, in the event of his arrest, in connection with the aforesaid case, he shall be released on pre-arrest bail on furnishing a bond of Rs. Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority subject to the following conditions that:-

- (i) the petitioner shall appear before the I.O. within 10 (ten) days from today.
- (ii) the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the

Investigating Officer as and when required thereafter;

- (iii) the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or any other police officer, and
- (iv) the petitioner shall not hamper with the investigation or tamper with the evidence of the case.

7. List the matter again on **07.08.2026**.
