Heard Mr. S.C. Biswas, learned counsel for the petitioner. We have also heard Mr. J. Payeng, learned Standing Counsel, FT and Standing Counsel, Border Police, Assam, Ms. G. Hazarkia, learned Central Govt. Counsel for the Union of India as well as the NRC Coordinator and Ms. B. Das, learned counsel for the Election Commission of India.

On such appearance, the petitioner may be released on furnishing a bond of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Superintendent of Police. The concerned Superintendent of Police may also take steps for capturing the finger prints and biometric of iris of the

petitioner's eye balls, if so advised.
